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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Götzis

Götzis is located in the center of Vorarlberg's Rhine Valley (between Kommingen and the Hohe Kugel) 448 m above sea level. It is the shopping and service metropolis of the Kuppen region.

In less than half an hour most parts of Vorarlberg and a considerable part of the Bodensee (Lake Constance) region can be reached, for example the skiing paradise Montafon, the Bregenzerwald or Lindau (DE), St. Gallen (CH) or Vaduz (LI).

Population: 12.090

Water Quality: Tap water in Götzis is drinkable.

Business Hours: Grocery stores are typically open Monday to Saturday from 8.00 until 19.00 and closed on Sundays.

Currency: Euro (€)

Cash can be withdrawn at ATMs.

Electricity: The standard voltage in Austria is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. Power plugs and sockets are of type F.

Meals

All athletes and accredited coaches will be accommodated on a full-board basis.

All meals will be served in buffet style in the Hotel Restaurant except for lunch on competition days and dinner on Sunday. Please present your Accreditation Card upon request.

For lunch and dinner, sealed water bottles will be provided free of charge. All other drinks have to be paid for. There will also be water dispensers where bottles can be refilled.

Important information: Any special diets (celiac, vegan, vegetarian, etc.) should be communicated to the LOC in advance.

Extra Charges

Any outstanding costs (e.g. minibar, extra drinks in the catering area) must be settled by cash or credit card with the hotel front desk prior to departure.

Meals in the Mösle Stadium

The LOC will provide a buffet of hot dishes in the “Team Hospitality” (see Appendix 1b) and refreshments in the “Sportlerstüble” (lounge for athletes and coaches) which will be located on the ground floor in the grandstand (see “Athletes Buffet” in Appendix 1d).

7. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation Card

Athletes and official coaches will receive an Accreditation Card which must be worn visibly at all times and presented upon request. The Accreditation Cards will be distributed at the Technical Meeting on Friday, 17 May.

The Accreditation Card is non-transferable and does not allow the holder to take another person beyond checkpoints. It will grant access to the following areas:

- stadium
- changing rooms / rest area
- “Sportlerstüble” (lounge for athletes and coaches in the Team Area)

Coaching Zone Pass

To access the reserved coaching zones for the high jump and pole vault (see Appendix 1c) a special Coaching Zone Pass is required.

8. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Technical Information Centre (TIC) – “Meeting Office”

The TIC is located in the Mösle Stadium on the first floor in the grandstand (see Appendix 1d).

The main task of the Technical Information Centre is to ensure a smooth communication between the teams, the Local Organising Committee, the World Athletics Technical Delegates and the Competition administration regarding technical matters.

The TIC will be open as follows:

The TIC is responsible for the following matters:

- Competition-related information including start lists and results
- Record forms
- National record doping control requests
- Written appeals

Competition-related information (start lists and results) for the different teams will be provided at the Information Desk (see Appendix 1d) as well as displayed on the screens in the central aisle of the grandstand.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on Friday, 17 May at 15.30 in the “Team Hospitality” (see Appendix 1b) in the Mösle Stadium.

At least one representative from each team shall attend the Technical Meeting. A bus shuttle service to the Mösle Stadium will be provided.

The Technical Meeting will provide updates and information which is not already mentioned in this Team Manual and will include:

- Timetable amendments (if any)
- Start lists (heats, groups)
- Starting heights for the vertical jumps
- Coaching zones
- Information desk
- Doping controls
- Accreditation cards

Implements

The official implements can be found in Appendix 2.

Personal implements will also be allowed, providing that they have World Athletics certification and have been checked prior to the event.

The checking will take place on the ground floor of the press stand (= tower adjacent to the grandstand, see Appendix 1d) and can be done during the following hours:

Please make sure to take your personal implements (shots, discs, javelins, poles) back to the Team Hotel after the competition!

Changing Rooms / Rest Area

The Changing Rooms are located in the grandstand (see Appendix 1d). Massage tables will be set up in the Changing Rooms which will be marked with the World Athletics Member Federation Code (e.g. Austria = AUT). Additionally, there will be a tent adjacent to the grandstand where massage tables can be set up.

The Rest Area will be located in block G of the grandstand (see Appendix 1d).

Training

The Mösle Stadium will be available for training from 09.00 to 18.00.

Official trainings, where a bus shuttle service will be provided, will take place on the following dates:

Gym

Athletes may work out in the gym “Vitalcenter Bitschnau” (Im Buch 45, 6840 Götzis, see Appendix 1e). The gym is open from 08.00 to 22.00.

Coaching Zones

Dedicated Coaching Zones will be provided for field events close to the event site (see Appendix 1c).

The Coaching Zones for the high jump and pole vault will be accessible by means of a special “Coaching Zone Pass” (one per athlete). This pass is transferable and must be worn visibly at all times. The pass is only valid in combination with an Accreditation Card.

Information Desk

The Information Desk is located between the grandstand and the track (see Appendix 1d). The latest start lists as well as all results will be provided for every team. This information will also be displayed on the screens in the central aisle of the grandstand.

9. COMPETITION RULES

Competition Bibs

Every athlete will receive two bibs which shall be worn visibly on the front and on the back. In the jumping events, athletes can decide to wear only one bib on the front OR on the back.

The leading athlete after each event will receive a “LEADER” bib which shall be placed on the front.

The bibs must be worn as issued and may not be cut, folded or obscured in any way.

Clothing

Paragraph 5.1 of the World Athletics Technical Rules will strictly be applied. Any advertising on clothes must comply with the latest World Athletics Advertising Rules and Regulations.

10. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Timetable

The timetable can be found in Appendix 3.

Warm-up Area

The Mösle Stadium as well as the adjacent field can be used as Warm-up Area.

Call Room

The Call Room is located in a tent adjacent to the grandstand next to the physio tent (see Appendix 1d). All athletes must present themselves to the call room prior to the first event of each day.

The procedure in the call room includes:

- Checking of competition bibs
- Checking of athletes' uniform (i.a. advertising)
- Checking of shoe spikes (number, shape and size)
- Inspection of personal belongings (i.a. electronic devices)

The call room will be open as follows:

Starter's Commands

The Starter's Commands will be given in English as follows:

In races up to and including 400 m

- "On your marks"
- "Set"

In races longer than 400 m

- "On your marks"

All races will be started by the firing of an electric gun. For recalls, an ordinary gun will be fired. A Start Information System will be used to detect a false start.

In case the Starter is not satisfied that all is ready for the start to proceed after the athletes are on their marks, the command will be:

- “Stand up”

High Jump and Pole Vault: starting heights and raising of the bar

Timing and Distance Measurement

Official timing will be provided by OMEGA Ltd.

Electronic Distance Measurement provided by Leica Geosystems AG will be used to determine the results in the Long Jump and throws (Shot Put, Discus and Javelin Throw).

High Jump and Pole Vault will be measured manually.

Leaving the Competition Area

During an event, no athlete may leave the Competition Area without permission from the Chief Judge. In cases where an athlete must leave the Competition Area, an official must escort the athlete.

Protests and Appeals

Protests and Appeals will be handled according to World Athletics Rule 8 of the Technical Rules, an extract of which appears below. Protests and Appeals will be handled by the Technical Information Centre (TIC).

Protests

Protests concerning the result or conduct of an event shall be made within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the result of that event.

Any protest shall be made orally to the Referee by an athlete, by someone acting on their behalf or by an official representative of a team.

Where the Referee is not accessible or available, the protest should be made to them through the Technical Information Centre (TIC).

Appeals

An appeal to the Jury of Appeal must be made within 30 minutes also through the Technical Information Centre (TIC):

- (a) of the official announcement of the amended result of an event arising from the decision made by the Referee; or
- (b) of the advice being given to those making the protest, where there is no amendment of any result.

It shall be in writing, signed by the athlete, by someone acting on their behalf or by an official representative of a team and shall be accompanied by a deposit of EUR 75, which will be forfeited if the appeal is not allowed.

The decision of the Jury of Appeal will be provided in writing.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES & DOPING CONTROLS

Medical Services

The Medical Services is in charge of providing primary and emergency care as well as any other medical support service to all accredited persons (athletes, coaches, LOC, VIP and media). During the competition, this also applies to the spectators in the Mösle Stadium.

Medical Care at the Competition Venue

The Medical Team in the Mösle Stadium (doctor, physiotherapist) is responsible for all health care services of the athletes. A medical room will be provided on the ground floor of the grandstand (see Appendix 1d).

Medical examination/treatment and/or physiotherapy may be provided

- on the competition area itself ONLY by the official medical staff appointed by the LOC
- in designated medical treatment areas outside the competition area by accredited team medical personnel (World Athletics Rule 6 of Technical Rules).

Cost for Medical Care

In the Mösle Stadium, first aid treatment and emergency care to accredited team members will be provided by the LOC free of charge.

Any costs incurred for example through additional medical care after first aid or transport to the hospital by ambulance or helicopter must be paid by the patient and/or team through an appropriate medical insurance coverage. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that all accredited persons have an insurance that covers illness and/or injury. The LOC will not pay any additional costs after first aid.

Ice for Physiotherapy

Ice for physiotherapy will be provided for all athletes in the medical room in the centre aisle of the grandstand (see Appendix 1d).

Additionally, there will be a tent with an ice bath adjacent to the grandstand.

Doping Controls

General Information

Sample Collection will be conducted in accordance with World Athletics Competition Rules and Anti-Doping Regulations and will be overseen by the World Athletics Technical Delegate.

Athletes for testing will be notified of their selection by an anti-doping official.

The athlete will be required to sign a doping control form and to show their passport (ID-card; Accreditation Card not sufficient!) before providing the sample.

Selection of Athletes

The selection of athletes is up to the World Athletics Technical Delegate.

Additional Controls

If an athlete requests to have Sample Collection carried out for e.g. the authentication of a National Record, such a test will be carried out on a fee-payable basis. The test needs to be requested through the Technical Information Centre (TIC) where a doping control form needs to be filled out. The athletes will then be escorted to the Sample Collection Station.

Sample Collection Station

The Sample Collection Station will be located near the Mösle Stadium (see Appendix 1e) and athletes will be escorted by officials.

12. CEREMONIES & SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

Community Reception

The Community Reception facilitated by the community of Götzis will take place on Friday, 17 May at 19.00 at the event location Kulturbühne AMBACH (see Appendix 1a).

The top ten decathletes and heptathletes will be presented. The affected athletes will find further information in their Welcome Folder.

Opening Ceremony (“Star Parade”)

A small Opening Ceremony will take place on Saturday, 18 May at 10.30 in the Mösle Stadium.

The top ten decathletes and heptathletes are asked to gather in the central aisle of the grandstand five minutes prior to the “Star Parade” (10.25). The affected athletes will find further information in their Welcome Folder.

Victory Ceremonies

A Victory Ceremony (“Patronanz”) for the winner in each event will take place shortly after the respective event.

The athlete achieving the highest score in one event will receive the “Hypo-Cash”.

After the “Hypo-Cash”, the “Rookie of the Meet” (athlete selected by the Jury) will be awarded.

Finally, the first ten athletes will each be presented with a trophy.

Farewell Dinner

The Farewell Dinner will take place from 20.15 on Sunday, 19 May at the event location Kulturbühne AMBACH (see Appendix 1a).

Prize Money

Details about the awarded prize money can be found in Appendix 5. The stated prize money is gross, and the tax deduction will be considered according to the double-tax agreement when the payment resp. bank transfer is done.

The payment will be done as part of the Farewell Dinner at the event location Kulturbühne AMBACH. Athletes are asked to bring the completed form “ZS-QU1” with them (residence declaration, can be found in the Welcome Folder).

As the payment for athletes is preferably done by bank transfer, it is required to indicate the bank details (BIC and IBAN).

Athletes selected for Sample Collection will only receive their Prize Money in case the Doping Control results return negative.

13. DEPARTURES

Athletes and coaches will receive a departure form containing flight details. Please return the form to Walter Weber after checking all information carefully and after adding any relevant changes.

A bus shuttle service will be organised according to the flight details. The transfer schedule will be posted at the reception desk in the Team Hotels as well as in the central aisle of the grandstand in the Mösle Stadium.

Important information: The departure times will strictly be kept!

The LOC will not cover any additional cost needed for transfer in case the transfer service will not be made use of or the shuttle bus will be missed.

However, the LOC can organise a cab ride to Zurich airport. This reservation must be made no later than Saturday evening and EUR 270.- will be charged.



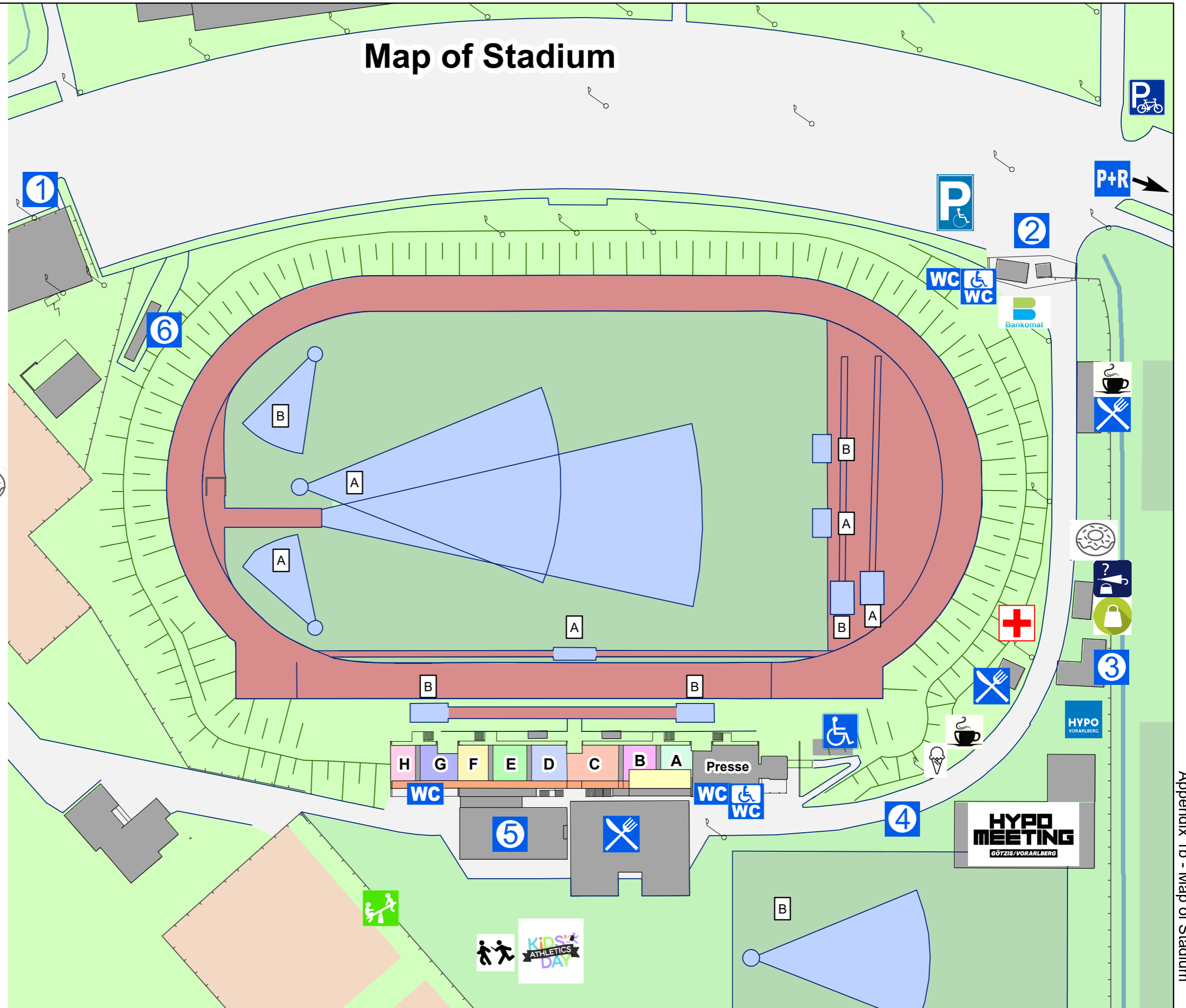

Map of Stadium

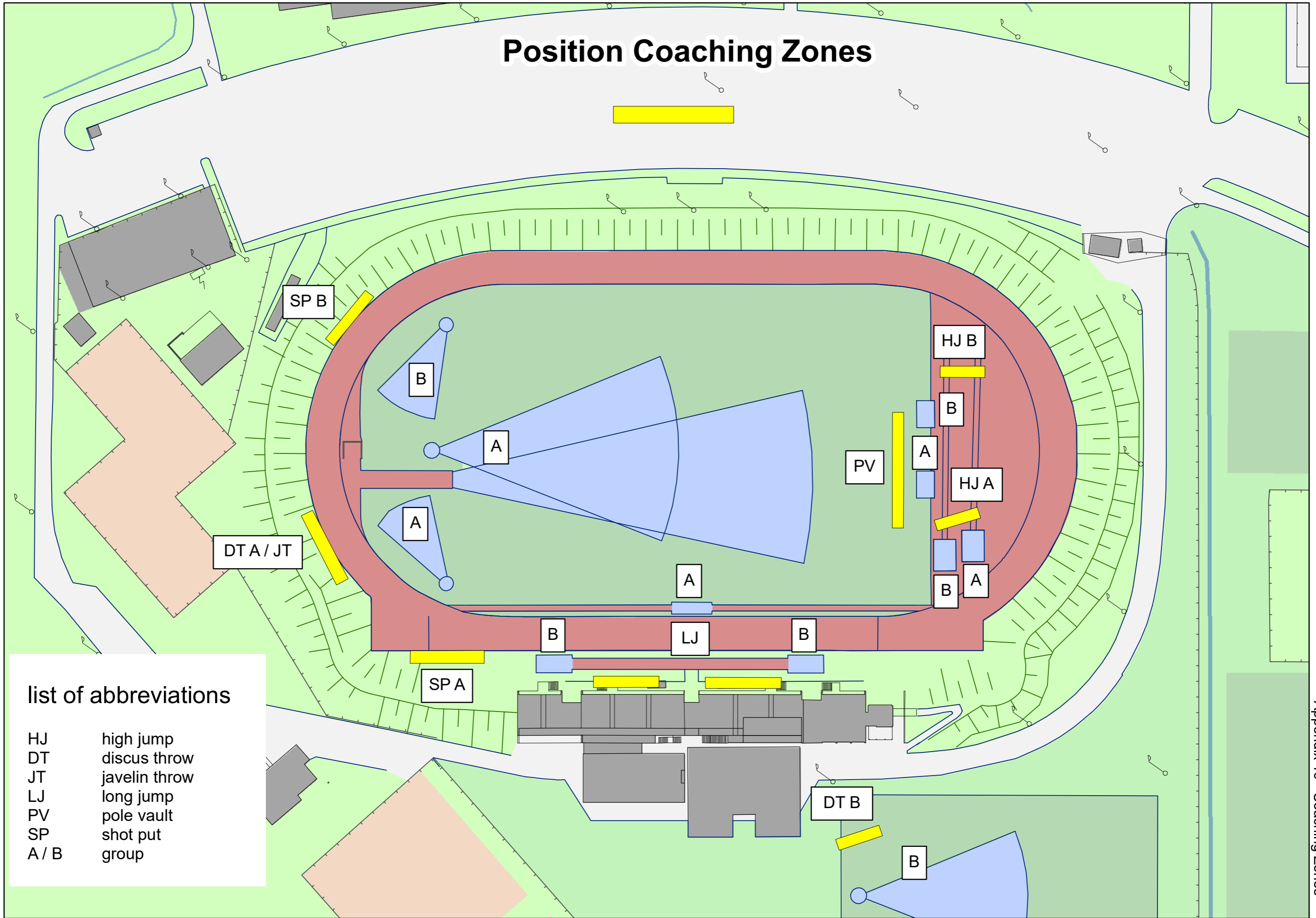

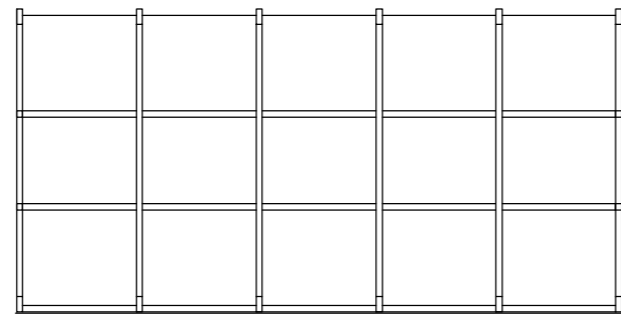

1. Floor

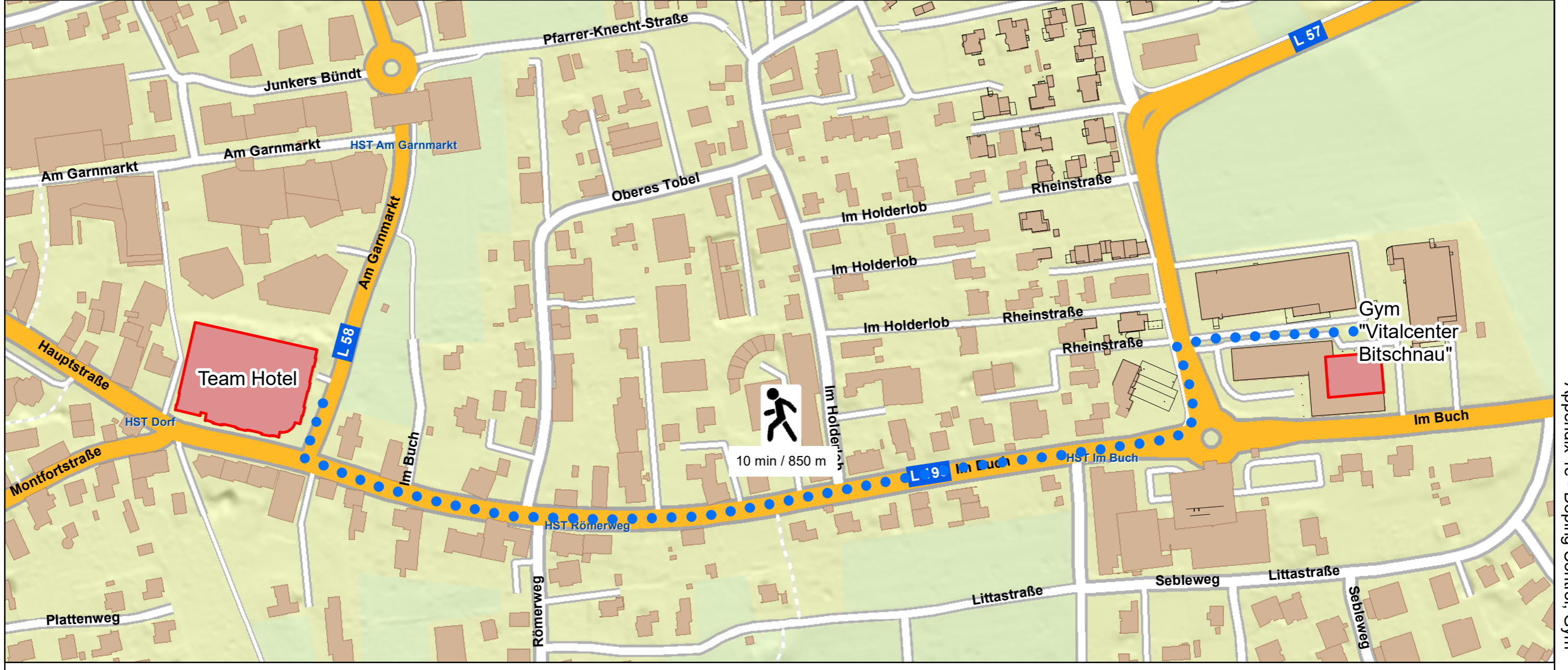
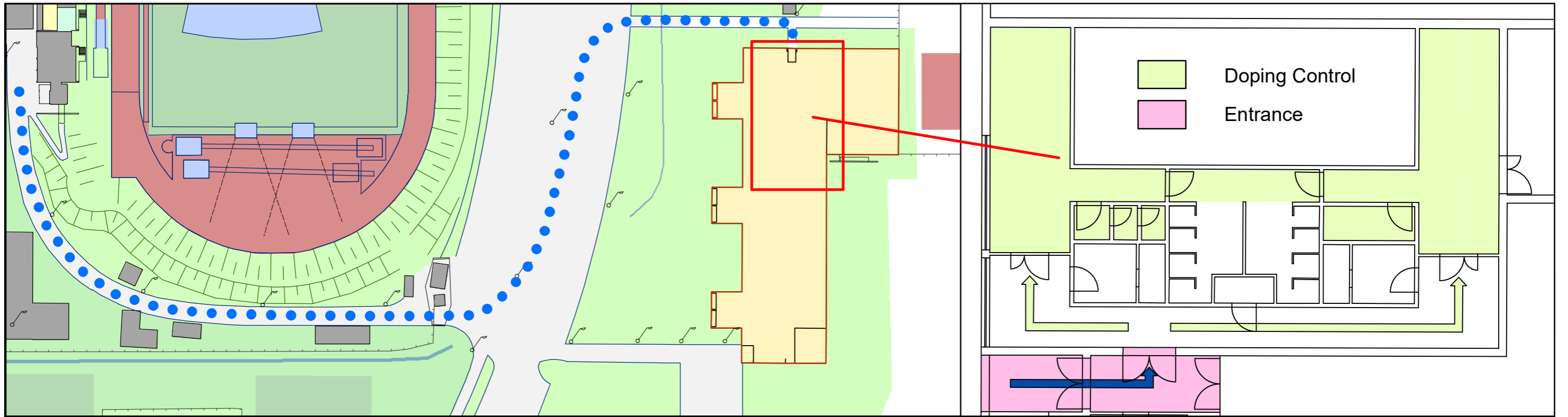

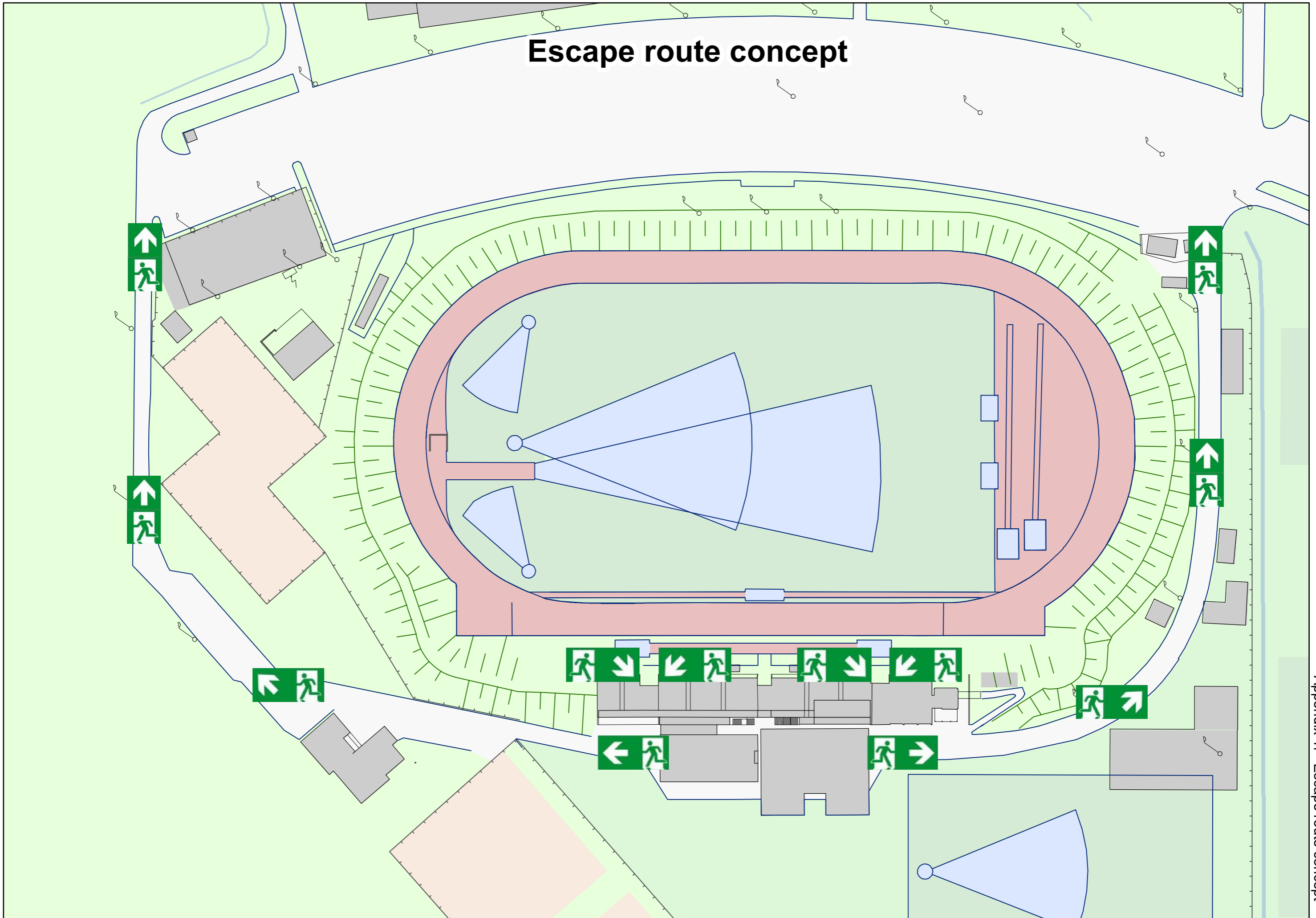
